

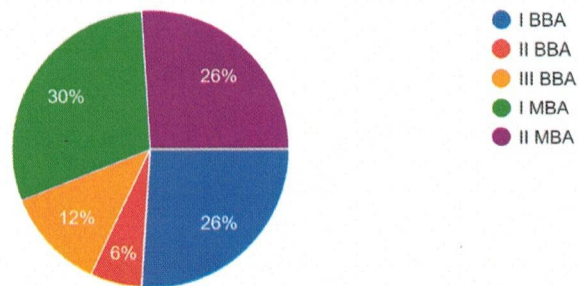


**Feed Back Analysis Report of Student Feedback for the Course/Curriculum**

**Academic Year -2019-20**

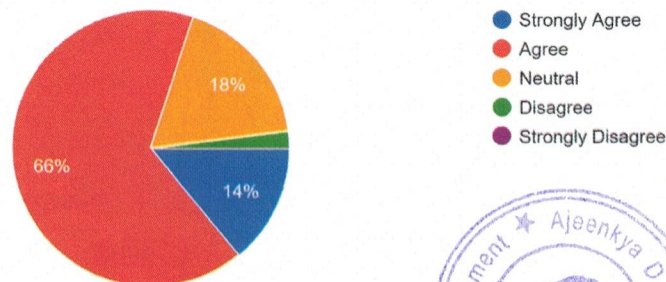

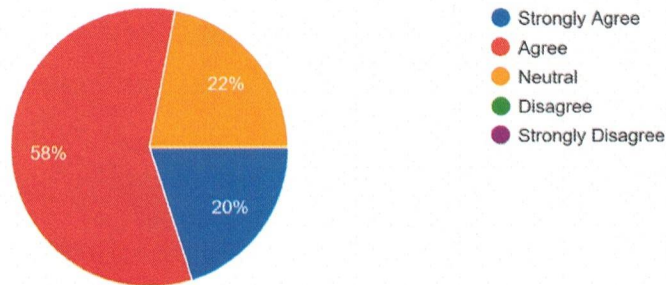
Course Contents are Job Oriented

### Curriculum helps in intellectual development

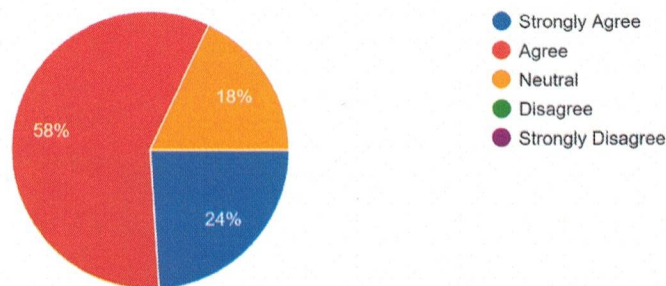
50 responses

50 responses



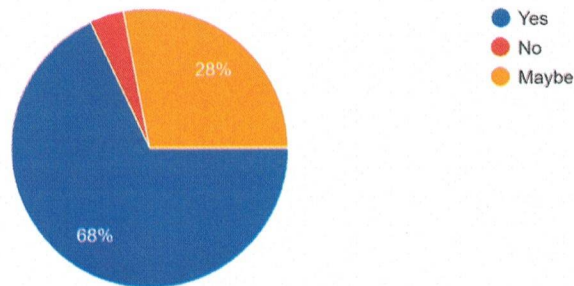

### Current Business Trends are included in the curriculum

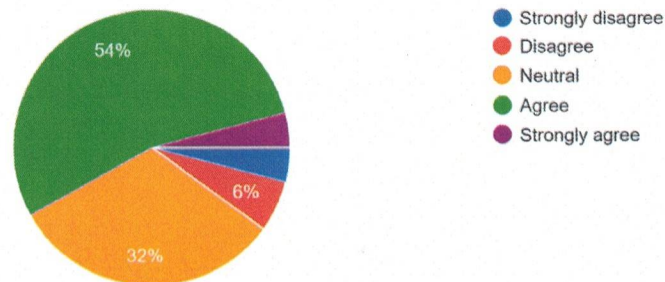
