Subject: Approval of Project Grant as per proposal dated 23rd December 2021.

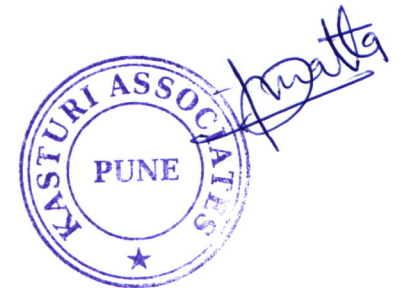
Dear Educator,
