Academic Highlights

Space Frame Structures Workshop

The Third Year B. Arch - Studio 21 students, Ajay Dalvi and Dhanashri Kosru, recently participated in the Summer Winter School Program on Space Frame Structures, organized in collaboration with Manavkruti Architecture, Pune. Led by Ar. Poonam Solanki and Ar. Akash Shah, the 5-day focused hands-on program on experience in creating Space Frame Gates and Tensegrity Towers.

Key Highlights:

Design Concept: The students collaborated on designing a dynamic entry gate for the workshop, featuring a triangular grid form within a space frame structure. Emphasizing minimal ground support, they innovatively utilized bamboo as the primary material and steel for connectors, offering environmentally friendly solutions. The structure's dimensions were 26'X13'X11'."







Field Trip Report: Vector Active Systems Study

On January 29, 2024, Second Year B. Arch. - Studio 22 students embarked on a field visit to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Museum, Wadgaon Shinde Road. Led by Prof. Amit Shirke, the visit aimed to explore vector active systems as part of the Building Material & Construction – Sem IV curriculum. A total of 18 students participated in the excursion.

Key Highlights:

During the visit, students had the opportunity to observe eight distinct types of vector active systems spanning the past two decades. This hands-on experience provided valuable insights

into both conventional and contemporary construction methods. Additionally, the excursion enhanced their understanding of pre-engineering building structures, a crucial aspect of their second-year studies.


Visit to Mattruchhaya Orphanage




Case Study: Enhancing Strategic Decision-Making


