


# ANNUAL REPORT 2020-21


Faculty engages with students in small groups and on a one-to-one basis, to encourage an 'individual response to set briefs. Our teaching and learning processes promote research, experimentation, analysis, evaluation, and selfcriticism - all of which assist in arriving at the best possible solutions to a given academic or industrial challenge. Imparting appropriate and transferable practical skills is central to the learning strategy of the program. Initiative and independence is fostered throughout and develops incrementally as the course progresses. Analytical and problem-solving skills are developed using a range of appropriate 'real' and 'theoretical' case studies and problem / task-based learning scenarios. Knowledge is assessed, formatively and summatively, by several methods, including, practical work, individual and group presentations, written coursework, laboratory experimentation, examinations (seen and unseen, open and closed-book). A personal development plan for each student is planned at the beginning of the year which encourages students to set targets for their own personal development under the active guidance and mentoring of an appointed personal mentor.



## First International Symposium: Purview in Medical and Food Biotechnology





**Dr. Robert Jensen is an Emeritus Professor in the School of Journalism and Media at the University of Texas in Austin, USA.** He collaborates with the Ecosphere Studies program at The Land Institute, and with New Perennials Publishing and the New Perennials Project at

Middlebury College. He is the author of The Restless and Relentless Mind of Wes Jackson: Searching for Sustainability (University Press of Kansas, 2021). Jensen is host and associate producer of "Podcast from the Prairie, with Wes Jackson," and associate producer of the forthcoming documentary film "Prairie Prophecy: The Restless and Relentless Mind of Wes Jackson."Jensen is coproducer of the documentary film "Abe Osheroff: One Foot in the Grave, the Other Still Dancing" (Media Education Foundation, 2009), which chronicles the life and philosophy of the longtime radical activist.



Dr. Vinitha Guptan is the Vice-Chancellor of Saito University College, Malaysia. She has also held various key positions in her long tenure of almost 20 years in higher education. She expertly drives strategic aims across quality, sustainability, competitive advantage, revenue, research and enrolment. Professionally and academically qualified with a Doctorate, coupled with industry experience, her both forward thinking and unconventional. As a keen researcher, Dr Guptan has published numerous articles on transforming higher education.

**Dr. Daren Timmons is University of South Carolina Aiken's Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs,** managing all academic programs and academic support services including enrollment management, admissions, and financial aid. He understands systems and people, is adept at building both community and international partnerships, and grasps the joys and challenges of the faculty and staff. Dr. Timmons leads with integrity, compassion, courage, and humor. Dr. Timmons also sits on the Advisory Committee on Academic Programs for the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education, and is chair of the board of the non-profit organization Citizens for Nuclear Technology Awareness. Before coming to UofSC Aiken in 2016, Dr. Timmons was the John C. Allen '62 Institute Professor of Chemistry and head of the Chemistry Department at the Virginia Military Institute in Lexington, VA where he developed new liquid crystal materials and metal-organic frameworks. He received his Bachelor of

Science degree in chemistry from Duke University and his doctorate in chemistry from Texas A&M University.

Dr. Vijay Khare is a Professor & Head, Department of Defense and Strategic Studies (DDSS), Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune (SPPU). He was awarded a Partial Fellowship by the United Nations University, Tokyo, Japan. Dr. Khare was selected for the United Nations Short Course on 'Hologrammatic Terrorism' United Nations, Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute, University of Rome, Italy. He completed an Executive Leadership Program and Advanced Mediation and Peacemaking program at the University of London, UK. Fellowship Awards: Dr. Khare is a recipient of the prestigious Fulbright Fellowship at Washington D.C.USA. He had been awarded the Erasmus Fellowship by the European Commission at Masaryk University Czech Republic. Moreover, he received the Social Scientist Award for his research work under the Indo-French Social Scientist Exchange Programme at the Foundation Maison des Sciences de l'Homme, Paris, France. He was invited by the US State Department under the International Visitors Programme to attend the 'US Multilateral Diplomacy' program and visited several universities in Washington DC, San Francisco Texas and New York under US State sponsored Program. He also completed "Academy Leadership Academy " Programme at the Center for the Study of Higher Education, Penn State University, USA. Regarding research, he received a Postdoctoral Fellowship from the University Grants Commission (UGC).

Dr. R. Raj Rao is a writer and teacher of literature and one of India's leading gay-rights activists. His 2003 novel The Boyfriend is one of the first gay novels to come from India. He received his PhD in English literature from the University of Bombay, and did postdoctoral studies from the University of Warwick. He is the author of Slide Show (poems), One Day I Locked My Flat in Soul City (short stories) and Nissim Ezekiel: The Authorized Biography. Poems from his 'BomGay' collection also served as the basis for Riyad Wadia's 1996 film Bomgay, said to be India's first gay film. Dr. Rao has held the position of a professor in the department of English, University of Pune(SPPU), founder of Queer Studies Circle, a gay-lesbian student group, and in his own words, a radical utopian. Sildeshow (Peepal Tree Press, 1992), poems, Image of India in the Indian Novel in English (1960-1985), co-editor with Sudhakar Pandey, Nissim Ezekiel: The Authorized Biography), One Day I Locked My Flat in Soul City (Harper Collins India, 2001), short stories, The Wisest Fool on Earth and Other Plays (The Brown Critique, Kolkata), The Boyfriend novel, Whistling in the Dark: Twenty-One Queer Interviews (Sage, 2009),co-editor with Dibyajyoti Sarma, Hostel Room 131 (2010), novel, Lady Lolita's Lover (Harper Collins India, 2015), novel, Ten Indian Authors in Interview, editor, Madam, Give Me My Sex (Bloomsbury India, 2019), novel. His poems appeared in many prestigious poetry anthologies like The Dance of the Peacock besides other noted Journals and anthologies.

## 71st year Celebration of "Constitution Day (2020-21)"

This year is the 71st year Celebration of "Constitution Day" on 26th November 2020. It was a 30-minute event organized by Ms. Priya Abraham.

Constitution Day or Samvidhan Diwas is celebrated annually in India on 26 November. The day is also known as National Law Day. The day commemorates the adoption of the Constitution in India.

The day is celebrated to promote Constitution values among citizens. The members of the Constituent Assembly signed two hand-written copies of the document on 24 January 1950 and two days later, it became the law of the land. The Constitution Day is celebrated as a mark of tribute to India's first Law Minister BR Ambedkar, who played a pivotal role in drafting the Indian Constitution.





## International Day of Yoga: (2020 - 2021)

The International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June 2021. The session was of 1 hour duration, in which faculty members participated to promote and bring awareness towards yoga, spirituality and mental health.

Yoga's origins can be traced to northern India over 5,000 years ago. The word yoga was first mentioned in ancient sacred texts called the Rig Veda. Yoga was refined and developed by Rishis (sages) who documented their practices and beliefs in the Upanishads, a huge work containing over 200 scriptures.

The idea for an UN-mandated International Day of Yoga was first proposed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his speech at the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) in 2014. In his speech, Prime Minister Modi called Yoga an "invaluable gift of India's ancient tradition" and called for the "harmony between man and nature" through Yoga. This initiative was backed by as many as 177 nations, the highest number of cosponsors ever for any UNGA Resolution of such nature.

2021 International Day of Yoga, to be observed today, carries the theme "Yoga for well-being", much relevant for our times in a society still recovering from the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

A United Nations statement, issued earlier last week, read, "A growing trend of people around the world embracing Yoga to stay healthy and rejuvenated and to fight social isolation and depression has been witnessed during the pandemic.

### **World No Tobacco Day (2020 - 2021)**

World No Tobacco Day was celebrated on 31st May 2021. The campaign aims to spread awareness about the dangers of tobacco and its negative impact on health, as well as the exploitation of the nicotine industry that is geared towards the youth in particular.

Each year, the World Health Organization (WHO) holds World No Tobacco Day on May 31. The goal is to spread awareness about the risks of tobacco use and how we can make the world tobacco free. Tobacco is the leading cause of respiratory disorders like chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, tuberculosis, and other lung diseases. In 2008, the WHO banned any kind of advertisement or promotion of tobacco. The World No Tobacco Day theme for 2021 is "Commit to Quit." On the day we all took the pledge to say No to tobacco consumption.






# Online Zumba class Jointly by WEE & #stayfitadypu



# ARAMBHA- A NEW BEGINNING by School of Hotel Management



The Conversation closed with student's feedback and an energetic Quiz and Conclusion by Professor Pranali Thorat.








## School of Film & Media


## 3. Title: Body Culture

## **School of Law**




The Webinar was organized in collaboration with the Srujan Welfare Society. The students understood the ideas behind fundamental rights and how we can exercise them.

It is pertinent to note that the micro-level studies conducted by UN Women, UNFPA, UNICEF, UNDP, WHO, and UNRCO particularly with reference to the Asian countries and in India itself, have identified inter alia the determinants namely, strong patriarchal values/ norms manifested through male-centric practices, hypergamy, access to unregulated technology and traditions undermining the human rights of women and unborn child. In the Indian context, the policies, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme, and laws have aimed at restoring gender equality and have played a protective and/ or preventive role by subverting gender-biased sex selection. However, the incidences of female foeticide continue to be reported creating a need for assessing the efficacy of the legal framework.



The webinar was envisioned so that the students of ADYPU are ready with all the documentation required to enter the world of law in action. The Webinar gave ideas about effective CV Building, Cover Letter Drafting, and Interview Etiquettes.










made students understand its importance for the current/ future and took away the great knowledge on good industry practices. It was indeed an interactive and knowledge-building session

#### **IoT Webinar**










#### **Training Workshop on Outcome Based Education**
