

The Covid pandemic guided us on how the education sector thrives in the face of adversity and made us shift the education paradigm to the technology-enabled ecosystem.

Faculty engages with students in small groups and on a one-to-one basis, to encourage an 'individual response to set briefs. 

It is difficult to imagine clothes without stitching. Button masala is a simple yet quickly adaptable way of making clothes without any tools and machines. It has developed over the last four years and it started with my explorations for the Lakme fashion week show.

The first concept of button masala was based on a grid system. The buttons were stitched on fabric at two inches. The separate fabric straps had button holes at the same distance as the buttons. The straps were then used to drape the fabric into a garment. In the next development, the buttons were inserted into the fabric and secured with the help of rubber bands. The whole garment can now be made without any machine or tools. Opening the whole garment and restructuring it according to need and size was possible. Three has been many more explorations after that in terms of product development with the technique. It is possible to make not just clothes but accessories, curtains, cushion covers, bags, shoes, furniture, and much more with the same method. It is also very easy to learn this technique. In the last 4 years, almost 5000 people have learnt the technique.

5. School of Fashion Design organized an event for prospective students. The students were shown the school and were encouraged to be a student at ADYPU in future. A fashion Swap workshop was conducted in which people were encouraged to donate their old clothes and try other's donated clothes instead of buying new clothes every time.
